They share insight from their years of intensive parenting experience gained while providing therapeutic foster care in their home to more than thirty children removed from families in crisis.

In a desire to cooperate with churches and mission organizations, Dallas and Anna Lee operate as biblical counselors rather than being state licensed counselors. They provide biblical discipleship counseling to individuals, couples, families and missionary candidates preparing to serve cross-culturally.

Dallas and Anna Lee have completed biblical counseling training in various counseling methods (SACC, NACC, ADT) and are certified marriage facilitators.

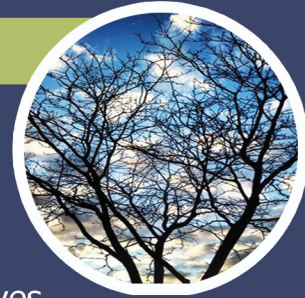
Our mission is to provide discipleship counseling for those who desire a safe and confidential place to learn and address their particular concerns biblically.
